For 2009 match points are, 24 for a win unless winning toss and batting second which is 20 points, 10 points for a tie, 10 points for a winning draw, either 4 or 2 points for a losing draw depending on attaining 75% of target / run rate, and 4 points for abandoned. Bonus points are 125,150,175,200 runs for batting divisions premier to 6, 100,125,150,175 runs for batting single teams, 3,5,7,9 wickets (or all out) bowling in all divisions - See handbook for full details.
